Procedural Instructions: the first ballot returned by the voter will be considered the official ballot (1-7.5-107(6), C.R.S.)

Mail Ballot Voting Instructions

1. Before attempting to vote your ballot, read the following instructions and the self-affirmation on the return envelope.
2. To vote, place a mark (x) in the appropriate box or line of your choice following the candidate's name, ballot issue or ballot question. Make the mark clear and distinct.
3. After voting, fold the ballot so your mark is concealed and place in the secrecy sleeve provided. This will ensure the secrecy of your ballot.
4. Place the ballot and secrecy sleeve in the return envelope and seal it. Complete the self-affirmation on the reverse side of the return envelope. **DO NOT FORGET TO PROVIDE YOUR SIGNATURE.** If you do not, your ballot will not be counted.
5. Apply the proper postage or deliver by hand to the address printed on the envelope.
6. In order for your ballot to be counted, it must be received by the Designated Election Official on or before 7:00pm on the Election Day.

**Ballots must be received by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.
DO NOT REMOVE THE STUB FROM YOUR BALLOT.**
